

Seven volumes complete, published between 1950-1956, comprising, "The Lion, The Witch and the Wardrobe", (1950), 172pp, [2]; "Prince Caspian", (1951), 194pp, [2]; "The Voyage of the Dawn Treader", (1952), 223pp, [1]; "The Silver Chair", (1953), 217pp, [1]; "The Horse and His Boy", (1954), 199pp, [1]; "The Magician's Nephew", (1955), 183pp, [1] and "The Last Battle", (1956), 184pp. Rebound in full blue goatskin by Temple Bookbinders, raised bands, spines in six panels, leather title label to second panel, author label to fourth, bands bordered by single gilt rules, covers with single fillet border, gilt to inner dentelles, a.e.g. Externally fine, internally one or two spots of foxing, but generally bright and clean. Housed in a velvet lined blue cloth slipcase. Hooper A20, 21, 23, 24, 25, 27 and 29 respectively
